## **Disability Access Statement**

### **2024 update**

Ladybrook is committed to being a fully inclusive school. Each year we review the limitations of the school buildings in terms of disabled access and endeavour to improve the environment for all.

In 2024 we have:

- Created an additional room within our open planned main building for small group learning in a quiet space;
- Created a sensory room with resources to support pupils who are over stimulated;
- Added wheelchair accessible fire doors to our school library to further ensure the safety of children.
- Updated our Accessibility Plan to reflect our ongoing commitment to equality of opportunity and inclusion.

The school building is single storey and semi-open plan. It is therefore relatively easy to access all areas. However, some doors as fire doors may present difficulties to wheelchair users. All staff are committed to ensuring that the school building is as accessible as possible. Any disabled person would be assisted to gain entrance to the building eg opening the door for wheelchair users. If necessary, we would ensure that a member of staff was available to open doors.
