### Disability Access Statement

#### **2018 Update**

Ladybrook is committed to being a fully inclusive school. Each year we review the limitations of the school building in terms of disabled access and endeavour to improve the environment for all.

In 2018 we have:

- Incorporated a ramp in the refurbished school library to ensure wheel chair access to the 'stage' area of the room;
- Written an accessibility statement to ensure equality of opportunity with regards to activities available upstairs in the refurbished library;
- Ensured that the new lobby/safety door is wide enough to allow access and egress in the main entrance at the front of school.

The school building is single storey and semi open plan. It is therefore relatively easy to access all areas. However, some doors may present difficulties to wheelchair users. All staff are committed to ensuring that the school building is as accessible as possible. Any disabled person would be assisted to gain entrance to the building eg opening the door for wheelchair users. If necessary, we would ensure that a member of staff was available to open doors.
