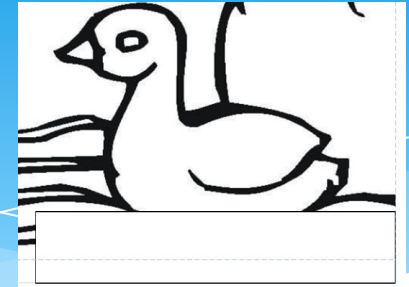


# How can you help?

# Floppy's Phonics

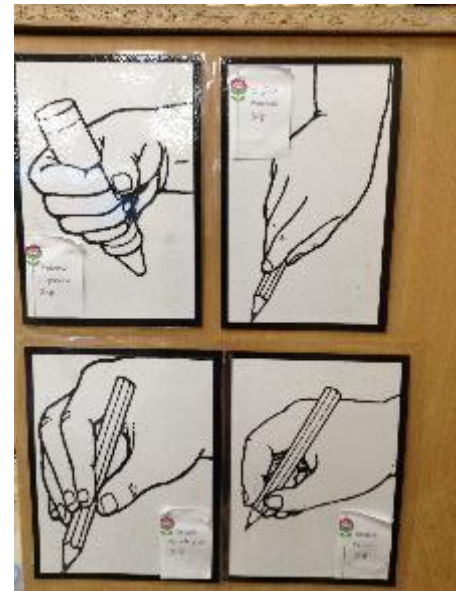


- \* Phase 1 phonics games played in whole class sessions in the Autumn term.
