Feelings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Begin to manage feelings positively and effectively• Know some of the things which can cause different emotions• Making simple/complex choices• Learn ways of taking personal responsibility
Friends	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise worth in others and say why someone is special to them
Growing up	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Know the correct names for the external parts of the body including the sexual parts• Have a basic understanding of some bodily functions and what is meant by hygiene/cleanliness• Know that animals; including humans, reproduce and that young animals grow to be adults• Understand that boys and girls can both do the same tasks and enjoy the same things• Understand that stories and television sometimes say that boys do this and girls do that• Know that different types of family have common features and functions• Know that there are similarities and differences between people eg gender, appearances, families, cultural backgrounds etc
